STAKES Texas Mile S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

(PLUS UP TO \$11,250 Open ATB) FOR THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start with \$200,000 guaranteed of which \$110,000 to the owner of the winner, \$38,000 to second, \$20,000 to third, \$11,500 to fourth, \$5,500 to fifth and \$3,000 for placing sixth through tenth. If less than ten horses start, the purse money not distributed will revert to the winning owner. Weights: Three Year Olds, 114 lbs. Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$90,000 at a mile or over in 2016 allowed, 2 lbs.; \$60,000 since November 1, 2015, 4 lbs.; \$30,000 in 2015-2016, 6 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in weight allowances. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Highweights preferred (on the scale). Total earnings in 2015-2016, as determined by the information provided by Equibase Company, will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to twelve starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

Footnotes

GREAT MINDS raced inside on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, chased in the two path on the far turn, shifted three wide into the stretch, made an outside bid near the eighth-pole, dueled with the runner-up, drifted out alongside that rival around the sixteenth-pole and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. SHOTGUN KOWBOY raced in the three path on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied in the two path on the far turn, was put to a drive at the three-sixteenths, dueled with the winner in the final furlong, drifted out near the sixteenth-pole and just missed while well clear for the place. CARVE brushed with a rival just after the start, went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a three wide bid on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, dropped well behind the top into the final furlong and weakened while just able to get the show. ACES HIGH brushed with a rival after the start, raced mostly in the two path on the first turn, settled just off the pace, was urged along in the four path on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and tired. JESSICA'S STAR bumped with a rival at the start, went five wide on the first turn, settled near the back on the outside, was roused in the two path on the far turn and failed to rally. BLUE TONE went three then two wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the inside of SHOTGUN KOWBOY, vied inside while urged along on the far turn and gave way. HIP FOUR SIXTYNINE brushed with a foe after the start, went four wide on the first turn, settled in the back half of the field, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. ENDURANCE went six then five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while five wide on the far turn and came up empty. WOLF MAN ROCKET bumped with an opponent at the start, went six wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear, raced four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor.
