

COWBOY DIPLOMACY broke outwards, prompted the leading duelers from the three path, vied three wide around the turn, drew clear of inner foes approaching the furlong pole, and widened his advantage under mild hand urging. ALL EYES WEST broke outwards, dueled for the lead inside of MOUNTAIN AIR and COWBOY DIPLOMACY through the turn, but was headed by the latter while getting the better of the prior in upper stretch, then kept on to secure place. MOUNTAIN AIR dueled for the lead two wide and between horses, but proved no match for his outer foe in upper stretch while failing to match strides with his inner foe. LAKE NIMROD stalked along the inside, shifted to the two to three path in upper stretch, and finished up evenly without producing a bid. RAG TAG saved ground while far off of the pace, but to no avail. WAR DETONATOR trailed along the inside into the turn, came into the lane in the three path, and passed tired foes without factoring. THE FEATURE was off a bit slow and bumped by an inner foe at the start, but recovered to be forwardly placed two wide and between horses, shifted to the four path turning for home, but failed to make a bid, and weakened. JESS MO was reluctant to load, then broke outwards from an inner foe, tracked from off of the pace in the four path, but weakened after being floated to the five path turning for home.
