INDIGO STUNNER stalked the pace in the two path, angled to the four path entering the stretch, rallied and was clear under mild handling. FIONN was unrushed early, rallied six wide on the far turn and closed strongly. TRIUMPHANT SPIRIT saved ground and bid late inside. HUMBLED saved ground, bid in the three path on the far turn, led in the stretch but faltered. LEAD THE WAY stalked the pace in the four path at the half-mile pole and faded. POWDERED SUGAR bumped with a foe at the start, dueled inside and faded in the stretch. MULTIPLICATION stalked between foes and faded in the stretch. SWEET STAR had a mild late bid in the three path. ARYAAM bumped with a foe at the start and saved ground. HONEY GIRL RUBIA dueled outside of a rival and gave way on the far turn.
