PERUVIAN LUCKY stalked the pace in the four path, rallied at the top of the stretch, was clear late and lasted under a steady drive. DOUBLE NEAT stalked the pace inside, angled to the four path at the top of the stretch, rallied and missed. MY BROTHER KEITH raced in the four path, rallied late and missed. SUPREME LEADER was unrushed between rivals, bid in the five path on the far turn, rallied in the stretch and missed. CABALLO FELIZ was clear early but couldn't hold off the closers. PICO D'ORO raced between rivals, angled in near the three-eighths pole and rallied late in the scrum. BACKYARD JUSTICE pressed the early pace, settled, stalked the pace between foes, bid inside near the three-sixteenths pole but had no closing bid. WISSAM SHARAF raced in the three path early, angled to the rail in early stretch, bid belatedly and faltered. FAST FALL stalked the pace in the two path but had no late bid. TRANSCENDENTAL bore out badly and was climbing early, bid in the four path at the quarter pole and passed tired rivals. BRIGHT SPARK saved ground to no avail. FIERCE ASSAULT stalked the pace inside and took up near the three-eighths pole when a rival came in to the rail.
